Need someone to talk to?

A **warmline** is a phone line that you can call or text during designated days and hours to:

- Get support
- Ask about resources
- Connect with another person who can relate or has “been there”
- Just talk

Warmlines are answered by trained peer support people who have first-hand experience of living with a psychiatric diagnosis, trauma, extreme or altered states, etc. and are there to talk and offer support. They are not clinicians or crisis staff. Depending on staff availability you may need to leave a message.
